The Bay of Somme

Getting there

- 60 minutes by car from Amiens to St Valéry-sur-Somme
- Possibility of taking the train to Noyelle-sur-Mer from Amiens SNCF station

The Cliffs of Ault

The cliffs of Ault, in Picardy on the Opal Coast, offer a striking natural spectacle with their white chalk walls overlooking the sea.

The village of Ault, perched on these heights, is a haven of tranquility attracting nature lovers. The coastal paths allow visitors to enjoy magnificent panoramas and invigorating sea air. This site is an essential natural treasure of the Picardy coast.
